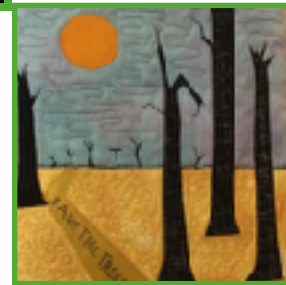


# Loving Earth Project
