Think of something you love: a place, a person, a thing.

How will climate change and environmental breakdown affect them?

What action is needed to reduce the risk of harm?

What could you do to help bring this about?

The Loving Earth project aims to help people engage with environmental breakdown without being overwhelmed. Inspired by the current exhibition in the Stables Gallery, we're offering two free workshops for you to make your own textile panel. The first will be to get started, the second to share work in progress and support each other to complete our panels.

After asking ourselves the questions above, we'll each choose an image to illustrate our response. This could be the thing you love, or something you will do. We'll start by sketching out a rough design on paper, then plan a textile panel (30x30 cm). It can be sewn, embroidered, felted, knitted or crocheted – ideally using leftover scraps and repurposed materials (bring whatever you have and there will be plenty available to share). No skills or experience are required, and help will be on hand if you need it.
